NOTICE REGARDING LEAVES PICK UP:

The Public Works Dept. will only be going around the town for <u>one</u> pick up although the calendar may indicate multiple days for example: Thursday and Friday. If they can complete the entire town on Thursday then they <u>will not</u> be collecting on the second day. If they do not complete the Borough in one day then the second day is to complete the unfinished portion of the Borough only. Public Works asks that you <u>please put your leaves out in plastic or paper bags prior to the first day of leaves being collected.</u> Leaves will only be picked up once a week during the collection period.

SINGLE STREAM RECYCLING -ACCEPTABLE

- Plastic bottles neck smaller than the base of the container like beverage, shampoo/conditioner, laundry/dish detergent, milk jugs, condiments, and salad dressings.
- Cans Aluminum, steel, tin and empty aerosol cans.
- Glass Bottles, Jars and Containers (All shapes, sizes and colors). Empty and rinse all bottles and containers. Remove all caps, lids and pumps and throw in trash.
- Corrugated Cardboard boxes.
- Clean Cardboard pizza boxes.
- Mixed Paper Magazines, catalogs, paperback books, hardcover books (cover removed), junk mail (including envelopes), office paper, computer paper, newspaper plus inserts, brown paper bags, construction paper, wrapping paper, greeting cards. DO NOT TIE OR BUNDLE PAPER, DO NOT BAG MATERIAL.

NOT ACCEPTABLE

- Shredded Paper, file folders, stickers or address label sheet waste
- Dairy tubs such as margarine, yogurt, sour cream.
- Gray/Chip board such as tissue, cereal, pasta, beverage carriers, gift boxes, paper to go containers, and paper towel/toilet tissue rolls, paper plates.
- Plastic flower/shrubbery pots, garbage cans or buckets, toys or totes, laundry baskets.
- Plastic food storage containers or lids, plastic fast food containers, cafeteria or microwave trays.
- Styrofoam of any type.
- Motor oil bottles.
- Bottle caps and jar lids (plastic or metal), plastic 6-pack holders, plastic cups, plates or bags.
- Waxed paper or waxed cardboard containers (milk or juice).
- File folders, stickers or address label sheet waste.
- Aluminum foil or plastic wrap, shrink wrap and stretch film.
- Aluminum throw-away pans, plastic or metal deli trays and covers.
- Dinnerware, glassware, window glass, mirrors, Pyrex dish/cookware, ceramic containers, ceramic knick knacks, light bulbs
- Garden hoses, plastic lawn furniture, plastic toys, plastic totes
- PVC pipe/tubing, plastic, metal drums, or 5 gallon water bottles
- Frozen food ice cream or frozen juice containers
- Shelf table carton or refrigerated cartons (Milk, juice, egg substitute)
- Pots and Pans
- Scrap Metal
- Aerosol cans for paint, lubricants, motor oil or other hazardous materials
