Beachfront: Chairman Scammell reported favorable consideration by the State of the Borough's 1965 Shore Funds application; that he had written to Freeholder Makin for an increased contribution by the County and that the Borough Clerk had written to Commissioner Roe with regard to the present financial status of the project.
