"Deadrise" The Making of the **Coastal Queen Restoration Series**



Filmmaker and local resident, Peter Slack, is documenting the restoration of Coastal Queen, a 65' converted Chesapeake Bay Buyboat built in 1928. The film series which began in 2021 is now in its 25th episode. Chesapeake Bay Buyboats like Coastal Queen were the 18 wheelers of the Chesapeake, hauling everything from oysters, fish, crabs, and produce. This talk will provide a behind-the-scenes look at how the series is shot, produced, and edited. Parts of episodes will be shown to illustrate examples of filming and editing techniques. The restoration is taking place in Portsmouth, Rhode Island. If you want to catch a glimpse of Coastal Queen, it will begin its journey south to the Barnegat Bay early this summer.
