

## October 21<sup>st</sup> Shipwrecks of the New Jersey Coast



Debbie Whitcraft, President and curator of the New Jersey Maritime Museum in Beach Haven, NJ., is dedicated to the preservation of NJ maritime history. Debbie will take us on a gripping voyage through the 'graveyard of the Atlantic' — a name bestowed upon New Jersey's treacherous shoals, sandbars and beaches. Debbie is concidered to be the foremost expert on the history of shipwrecks along the Jersey Coast. For thousands of sail to steam ships and even submarines, this coastline became

their final resting place. She will explore the history from the late 1700's to present day.
