DO I NEED A UCC BUILDING/CONSTRUCTION PERMIT?

While no list can be all inclusive, the following projects will generally require a UCC permit from our Construction Office:

- 1. Addition to an existing structure
- 2. Interior alteration or renovation
- 3. Deck
- 4. Finishing a basement
- 5. Enclosing a porch
- 6. In-ground or above ground pool, pool heater, hot tub or spa
- 7. HVAC work that includes installation or replacement of a condenser or furnace or the installation or replacement of duct work
- 8. Installation or replacement of a hot water heater
- 9. Installation or replacement of a fireplace or wood or pellet burning stove of any kind
- 10. Installation or replacement of a chimney or chimney liner
- 11. Installation or replacement of a stand by residential or commercial property generator
- 12. Installation of electrical wiring, lighting fixtures or electrical outlets
- 13. Installation of an underground sprinkler system
- 14. Installation or removal of an oil tank
- 15. Demolition of a shed or building larger than 200 square feet
- 16. Installing a concrete patio or deck
- 17. Construction of a retaining wall (three feet tall or higher)
- 18. Installation, replacement or removal of a solar power generating system
- 19. Installation of an electric vehicle charger station
- 20. Construction or Installation of a Shed (200 square feet or larger)

If you are not sure whether a project will require a permit, feel free to email your question to our Construction Office and you will receive a prompt response. Emergency repairs to your property are always allowed. It is asked that you or your contractor notify our Construction Office of the emergency repairs within two business days.

DOES MY PROJECT REQUIRE A ZONING PERMIT

Under the Borough Zoning Code (Chapter 32) the Borough is divided into several zones. In each zone, different primary and accessory uses of property are permitted. For instance, in the highway commercial zone you could operate a Hardware Store while such a use would be prohibited in the residential zones. This zoning protects our property owners and the quality of life in each distinct zone. Our Zoning Code also regulates structures that result in ground coverage so that runoff is controlled and flooding is minimized during periods of heavy rain.

In general, projects on your property that involve the placement of permanent structures, expansion of the footprint of your home or will result in additional non-porous or semi-porous ground coverage require a Zoning Permit prior to commencing work.

While no list can be exhaustive, the following are projects and activities on your property that are likely to require a Zoning Permit from the Borough:

- 1. Expansion of your home
- 2. Building of a garage or shed (larger than one hundred square feet)
- 3. Installation of a pool (inground or above ground), hot tub or outdoor spa
- 4. Building of a deck, patio, pergola or roof extension or overhang of any kind
- 5. Installation of accessory devices or structures (HVAC condensers, pools and pool equipment, generators, satellite dishes (ground mounted) and stairs
- 6. Installation of a driveway
- 7. Installation of a fence (higher than thirty inches)

If your project requires a Zoning Permit, you can find the Zoning Permit Application on the forms page of our website or you can pick one up at our Office. The Zoning Permit Application must be submitted with a survey of your property with an indication of the structure(s) you plan to add to your property and the proposed location(s). In the case of more complex or extensive projects such as building additions, garages and pools, you will have to submit a plot plan prepared by a licensed engineer or surveyor. The application review fee is \$100.00 which is payable via cash, check or money order at the time of submission.

UCC PERMIT APPLICATIONS

YOU WILL NEED TO SUBMIT THE FOLLOWING FOR YOUR PERMIT APPLICATIONS TO BE PROCESSED:

- 1. UCC permit folder/jacket completed and signed by either the contractor or the property owner.
- 2. For other than minor work or repairs you will need to submit drawings/plans prepared by the property owner, contractor or a licensed architect. All plans by contractors prepared by contractors or architects must bear their name and seal.
- 3. For other than minor work or repairs on commercial properties, sealed plans from a licensed architect are always required.
- 4. UCC tech sheets for each type of work being performed (building, electrical, fire, mechanical or plumbing).
- 5. When UCC permit applications are submitted by contractors, they must always submit a copy of their license(s).

When UCC permit applications are received by our Construction Office, they are reviewed by the licensed professional inspectors who are employed by the Borough. If your application passes the plan review phase you will receive an invoice so that you can pay for and pick up your permit(s). If your permit application does not pass plan review, you will receive an email or letter that explains the issue(s) that need correction or clarification. If you still have questions, you can come to our Office and meet with the Construction Professionals on Monday evenings between 6 PM and 8 PM or you can email your question(s) to the Constriction Office at the address provided and you will receive a prompt response.

In keeping with directives from the Division of Codes & Standards, the Borough of Island Heights is providing this notification to contractors and property owners with permitting requirements. These are the permits that are now required for the following:

- (1) Building may be required depending on type of chimney
