

ORDINANCE 2025-11

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF ISLAND HEIGHTS, COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING CHAPTER 19 OF THE BOROUGH CODE ENTITLED – PARKS, RECREATION AREAS AND OTHER PUBLIC SPACES

The following shall repeal and replace Chapter 19-2.8 of the Borough Code:


19-2.8. Vehicles and Trailers - Launching of Watercraft

- a. No person, except those enumerated below, shall bring, operate or park any motor vehicle upon any public beach, dock, boardwalk area, park area or other recreation area within the Borough unless they receive prior written permission from the Borough.
 1. Employees of the Borough in the performance of their duties
 2. Emergency vehicles

- b. Non-motorized watercraft that are eighteen (18) feet in total length or less may be launched at the following locations:
 1. The Borough Watercraft Launching Ramp located at the western terminus of Lake Drive
 2. Long Point Park on the beach area east of the groin
 3. The eastern terminus of Park Avenue
 4. The south end of Wanamaker Beach

- c. Motorized watercraft shall be launched only from the Borough Watercraft Launching Ramp located at the western terminus of Lake Drive.

The Foregoing Ordinance was duly adopted by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Island Heights at their Regular Meeting conducted on August 12, 2025 in the Borough.
